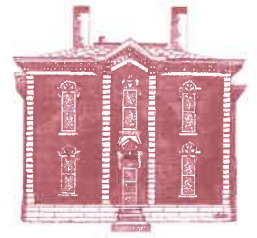

THE MINUTES
July 01, 2021

The Holmes County Commissioners met in regular session Thursday, July 01, 2021; with Mr. Eyler absent. Chairman Ault opened the meeting:

9:00 A.M. – LARA KIEFFER & JIM HENRY – FUNDING DISCUSSION

Lara Kiefer of the Child Advocacy Center and Jim Henry of the Sheriff's Office met with the Commissioners to discuss the budget cut for the Child Advocacy Center. Kiefer explained to the Board the Child Advocacy Center's process from the beginning to the end for children who have been sexually abused. They have a trained person that does a forensic interview with the child, the Sheriff's Office is there and watches the interview, and then have an examination if needed with a nurse that is specialized in sexual assault. Holmes County has two to three cases a week according to Henry. Their budget has been cut at the Child Advocacy Center and they are in need of \$40,000.00. Henry expressed how important this service is to Holmes County. He couldn't do his job without them. The decision was made for Holmes County to give \$20,000.00 in hopes that Wayne County will give \$20,000.00 also.

9:15 A.M. – DAN HILLER, LINDA CAMPBELL, ROCKY SNYDER AND BOB TURNER – UPDATE DISCUSSION

Dan Hiller & Linda Campbell of Nashville Village, Rocky Snyder of Holmesville Village and Bob Turner of Glenmont Village met with the Commissioners to update the Commissioners on their Villages water and sewer systems.

Dean Anderson of Blushift Wireless met with the Commissioners to discuss the quote for the Server Storage Upgrade for Adult Probation, Prosecutors, Victim Assistance and the Old Jail Office Building. Anderson explained that the Prosecutors is almost out of storage and this upgrade needs to be done sooner rather than later. The Commissioners gave their approval for the Server Storage Upgrade and also pay for the extra labor for each department to transfer their files over.
