**THE MINUTES**  
**November 10, 2022**

The Holmes County Commissioners met in regular session Thursday, November 10, 2022; with everyone present. Chairman Miller opened the meeting:

**9:00 A.M. – HOLMES COUNTY RECORDS COMMISSION MEETING – COMMISSIONERS MEETING ROOM**

**10:00 A.M. – CHRIS PRATT, DOUG HOOPER, KERRY TAYLOR & TIM MORRIS – COURTHOUSE LIGHTING DISCUSSION**

Chris Pratt of Jack Duffy & Associates, Kerry Tylor of Millersburg Electric, Doug Hooper of Midstate Contractors met with the Commissioners to discuss the lighting for the Courthouse Clock Tower. Pratt presented the lights that they would be putting on the Courthouse and the different lenses and also the different colors of the casing of the lights so that it will blend in with the Clock Tower. The lights will only use 11 watts of power. Timers were also discussed for the lights. Midstate will be making brackets to hold the lights so that it will mesh with the copper. The costs of the lighting is \$31,205.80 and with labor the total costs will be approximately \$125,000.00. The lighting brand is Ecosense. They will have a light that will be able to send the lighting in four different directions. Ecosense is no longer providing the design work on where to place the lights on the tower. Hooper has a firm Tech Studios that they use out of Columbus for design purposes. Hooper will get ahold of her once he gets back to Midstate. Also discussed was how to light up the Lady Justice, Ecosense would like to put a two-foot arm extended out and shine up on the Lady Justice and they will discuss the Lady Justice with Tech Studios. Pratt, Taylor and Hooper entertained questions from the press.
