**THE MINUTES**  
**August 24, 2023**

The Holmes County Commissioners met in regular session Thursday, August 24, 2023; with Commissioner Eyler absent. Chairman Miller opened the meeting:

**9:00 A.M. – SHERIFF TIM ZIMMERLY, PAM AKINS, CHAD JARVIS, RICHARD HAUN, KEVIN DEAN AND CHRIS YOUNG**

Sheriff Tum Zimmerly, Pam Akins, Chad Jarvis and Richard Huan of the Sheriff's Office, Kevin Dean of Dean's Backflow and Engineer Chris Young met with the commissioners to discuss the EPA Violations on the Jail Public Water System.

EPA Violations are as follows for the Jail Public Water System.:

1. Management and Operation Valve Exercise Program – where the valves are located
2. Well 002 casing integrity at the Board of Developmental Disabilities which is not abandoned – needs to be inspected for rust and corrosion
3. Backflow prevention device needs to be tested. There is no back up for the backflow prevention device and the Sheriff's Office would like the Commissioners to buy a back up backflow prevention device in case the current one goes down. They will determine who has the best price quote. The Commissioners agreed to pay for the backflow prevention device
4. Yard Hydrants have no backflow installed and they are not EPA certified. Dean will put the tap in in three weeks and Jerry Galbraith will also help with the removal of the hydrants.

Akins also went over the recommendations from the EPA also.

The ground water storage tank will also need to be inspected by the tenth year that it has been in place and it can cost up to \$32,000.00 to be inspected on the inside and make sure that when it is inspected that they do not get any contamination in the water storage tank. They inspect for any type of rust or corrosion that could be inside the tank.

**ADJOURN MOTION**

With no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Hall moved that the meeting be adjourned at 4:30 p.m.; Mr. Miller seconded the motion (Mr. Miller – yes; Mr. Eyler – absent; Mr. Hall - yes). The next scheduled business meeting of the Holmes County Commissioners is Monday, August 28, 2023.
